

DISTRICT JUDGE 2013 SCHEME - GENERIC FEEDBACK (SHORTLISTING TEST) (6 NOVEMBER 2013)

Introduction

This is the generic and anonymised feedback from the multiple choice shortlisting test in relation to the District Judge 2013 scheme.

Background

A total of 44 applications were received.

The Selection Committee decided on a multiple choice shortlisting test which was developed and validated in England and Wales as well as N. Ireland. The top scoring applicants in the test progressed to the Assessment Centre stage.

The Shortlisting Test

The multiple choice test consisted of 19 questions and applicants could attain a total of 95 marks. The answers attracted a range of scores between 0-5 marks.

Of the 44 applicants, 41 sat the test at various venues in N.Ireland. The table below highlights applicants' achievements in terms of the scoring bands and the percentage/numbers.
